WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

This is a fantastic project funded by the NHS East Lancashire Clinical Commissioning Group.

The project requires you to volunteer to work with and support socially isolated or vulnerable people across Burnley, Pendle and Rossendale who are at risk of hospital admission and repeated visits to their GP by socially connecting people to their local community and non-clinical services.

WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

You will be supporting individuals

that need a bit of extra support in their daily life to achieve wellbeing.

backgrounds need help for many different reasons. You will provide one-to-one support in the home or accompany people to local, non-clinical services.

- A full induction to the role
- Additional training including lone working, befriending and confidentiality
- Access to an accredited Level 1 Health Improvements course
- Access to wider BPRCVS training

You don't need any qualifications to be a Community Care Navigator. You just need to:

- Be 18 years+
- Want to help others in your community
- Be confident and supportive
- Have good interpersonal skills
- Be reliable and confidential

- Regular one-to-one supervisions
- Telephone support
- Support your personal development
